## Patient Rights at Pinnacle Pointe Behavioral Health care System

### It's All About ME!!!

As a patient at Pinnacle Pointe Behavioral Healthcare System, I have the right to:

- Be called by MY name, not a number or an illness.
- To be greeted with a smile and treated with loving care.
- To know, by name, which doctors, nurses, and other helpers will be taking care of me.
- To make choices whenever possible as long ad they don't get in the way of my care.
- To have my family members visit with me at visitation times.
- To have someone who speaks the same language as my family and I to help us understand what is happening, and if someone isn't available, to help my family find someone.
- To be told what's happening to me and have my questions answered in words my family or I can understand in our own language.
- ♦ To know my treatment is between me, my family, and the people caring for me and that it's no one else's business unless I say so.
- To leave the hospital as soon as possible with instructions from my caregivers so I can keep getting better.
- To have the papers about my health kept private, so that no one will know about me being here or why, unless they have a right to know or my family or I say it's OK.
- ◆ To be treated with the same loving care, no matter if I'm a boy or a girl, rich or poor, what color my skin is , whether I go to church, where I come from or who will pay for my stay
- ◆ To be cared for with courtesy and respect for the things I believe, like my faith, my heritage, my personal feelings, and what I think is important.
- To know the rules that I have to follow while I am here.
- To have the adult responsible for me to know what's going on with me while I'm here.
- To talk with a special adult caregiver, my advocate, if I feel my rights aren't being respected

#### The adult responsible for me is supposed to:

- Give Pinnacle Pointe all my past health information.
- Ask questions if there is something they don't understand.
- Tell Pinnacle Pointe staff if they are not happy with my care.
- Help plan my care and do their part of the plan.
- Respect the rights of other children, families and staff.
- Follow Pinnacle Pointe rules.
- Keep all appointments or call to change them when needed.

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
